Dinners

Following some confusion on whether children are vegetarian or not, we are introducing coloured wristbands. These will quickly indicate to the canteen staff whether the child only eats vegetarian or can eat meat as well.

We have green for vegetarian, blue for children that are mostly vegetarian but eat fish and red for children that eat meat. Children will then be given the correct food.

Please note if your child wishes to have vegetarian, though they might normally eat meat, this will continue to be allowed. However if your child has a green band then only vegetarian food will be served with no exceptions, even if they fancy eating chicken one day. The only way to change a category would be in writing to the office, we will not accept the child's word for it as that is when the confusion has occurred. The bands will also remove the need to stamp the hands.
