# Oadby Library

From Monday 1 April Oadby Library opening hours will be changing following the installation of smart library technology. Customers over the age of 16 will be able to access the library by scanning their card at the door to get access when staff are not present. Children under 16 will still be able to access the library during smart hours as long as they are accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 who has a smart library card. There will be a mixture of staffed and smart hours, so it's important for anyone wishing to use the library during smart hours to contact their library for an induction to the new system.
