Welcome

Welcome back to another year at Launde, we hope you have all had a good summer. It has been lovely seeing all the children in their smart new uniform looking very eager to learn.

Just a few reminders for the beginning of the year, please can parents remember that all children from year 1 upwards need plimsoles to change into. Please can this be rectified as soon as possible if you have not yet purchased any.

Reminder to all children who have long hair that it needs to be tied back so that it does not fall over their faces when they are trying to work and also not get caught when doing PE.

In assembly we did remind girls that they do not wear big bows on head bands and that they probably don't need their headband if the hair is nicely tied back. The other thing that is not part of school uniform is leggings with dresses or leggings at all. Children who need to cover their legs have the option of wearing trousers so there is no need to wear leggings under a dress.

Active Month

Following on from last year we will be encouraging children to be as active as they can be. Each month there will a different activity for children to follow. The children will then be rewarded for their efforts. We are going to be encouraging all children to participate in swimming lessons so the school lessons assist in improving swimming and not be the starting point for teaching. The younger the child goes swimming the more confident they are when swimming with school to improve techniques.

Over the coming months we will be focusing on walking, jogging/ running, dancing, yoga and building up endurance as part of the improved activity.

We want to encourage children to cycle to school but parents must ensure that the children do not ride their bikes on the school premises and more importantly that parents themselves model this to the children by not riding their own bikes through the school grounds. The same applies to scooters. Staff will be approaching all parents or children to ask them to stop doing this if it does arise.

Cycling is the active month activity for September.
