I would like to remind all parents that we are a nut free school and therefore children should not bring any form of nuts into school including in their lunch boxes. This also includes food products like peanut butter, Nutella, chocolate spread and anything else that may have strong elements of nuts. We are sorry we are having to remind you of this but we have had a recent incident of a child bringing in almonds which could have resulted in a child having a serious, life threatening allergic reaction. For this reason we are urging all parents to ensure that their child does not bring in any nuts or nut products into school.
