#### **AUTUMN TERM**


What a busy term we had! I would like to share with you some of the fantastic work which was produced last term by our Year 3 children who learnt to name and describe parts of the body, writing their own

#### **SPRING TERM THEMES**

**Year 2** will begin learning to identify masculine and feminine nouns and how adjectives in Spanish must agree with their nouns and therefore applying some tricky grammatical rules! They will continue learning to write the date, recap and extend numbers to 31 and say when their birthday is. They will also begin to name and describe parts of the body.

**Year 3** will learn to name animals and continue working on using adjectives for description.

**Year 4** will learn to name some fruit and vegetables ,talk about likes and dislikes, based on reading 'La oruga muy hambriega'.

**Years 5 and 6** will learn to talk about the weather, reinforce telling the time to the nearest hour and keep working on number patterns to 100, while reinforcing what they have previously learnt.
