We wrote and sent Easter wishes to our partner school in Madrid and have written letters about a typical day in our lives to pupils from our partner schools in Kenya and Argentina !

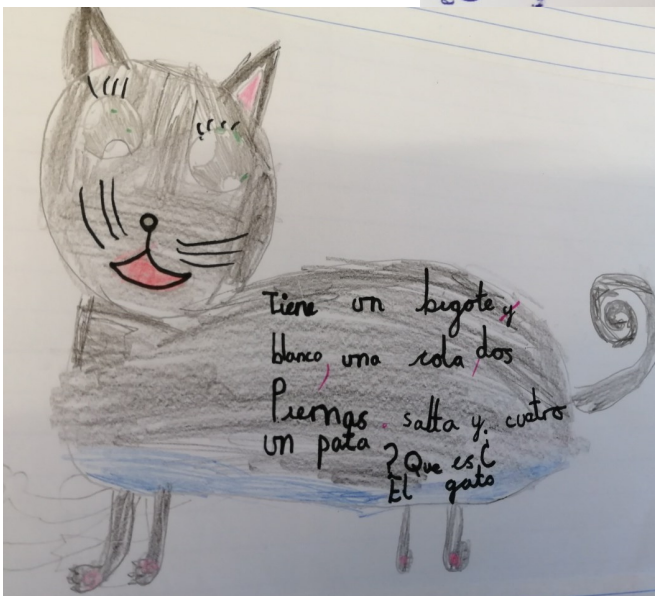
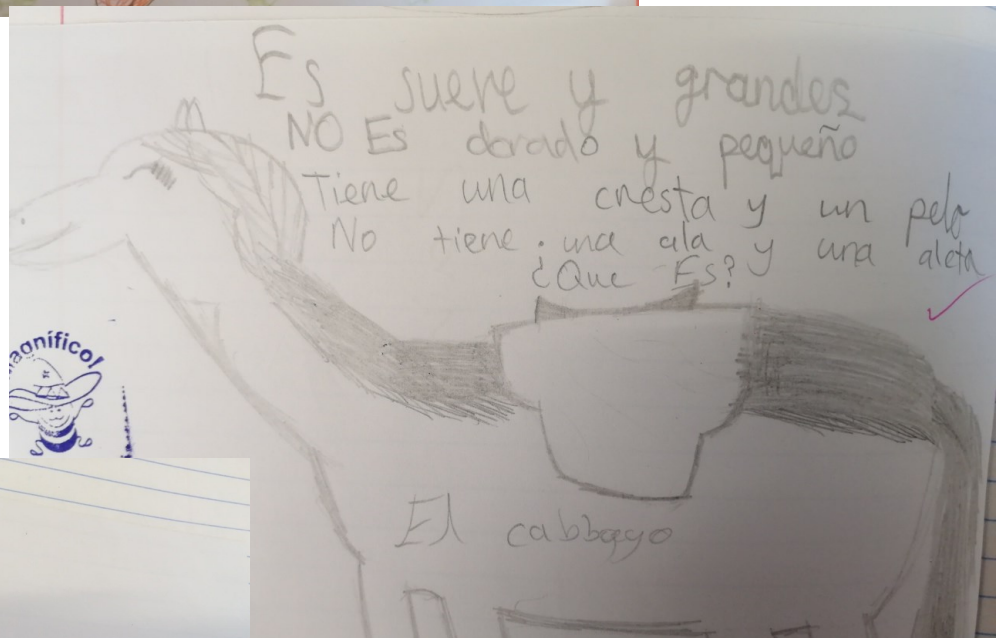
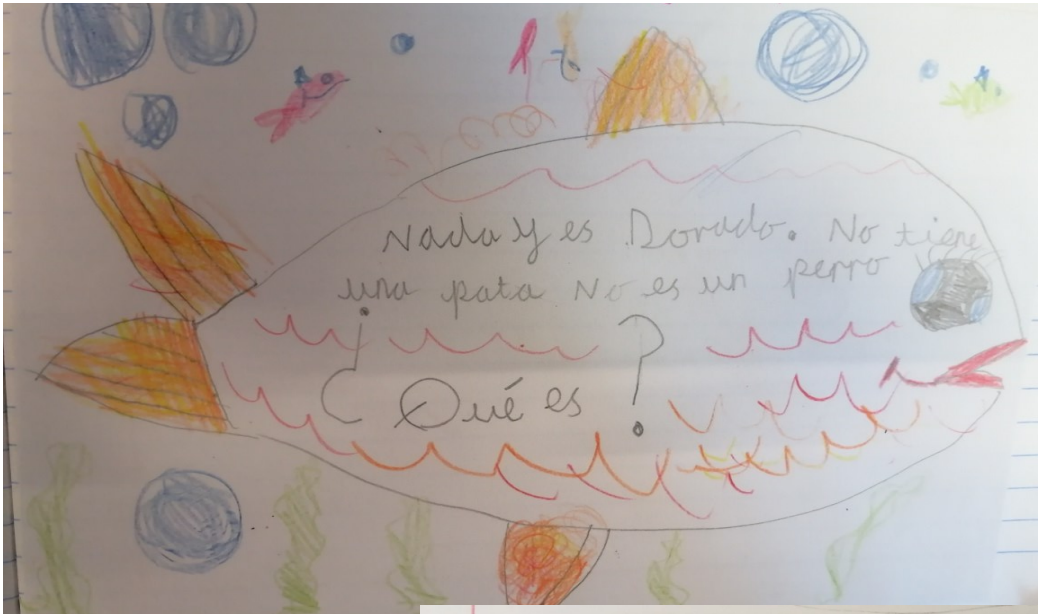
Next term, we will look at what we can do or change in our daily lives to bring sustainable changes to help the environment, both at school and at home !

## THIS TERM

**Year 4, 5 and 6** will reinforce previous learning by revisiting some previously learnt topics focusing on embedding basic grammatical knowledge, key vocabulary and working on speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.
