Christmas Concerts

Christmas Post Box

It has been good to see our post box being used this week. The Christmas post box is in the school reception area. Please make sure that all cards put into the post box are clearly labelled with the recipient's **name and class**.

Illness

There are a number of children who are coming into school when they are clearly very unwell. Please do not bring your child to school if they have a high temperature or sickness and diarrhoea.

We have two cases of scarlet fever in school. The symptoms may include sore throat, headache, fever, nausea and vomiting. After 12 to 24 hours a red pinhead rash develops which feels like sandpaper to touch. Children need to remain at home until 48 hours after a course of antibiotics has started.

Parking

We are still receiving complaints about parking from local residents. Please park sensibly and do not block driveways.

Residents at Tomlinson Court are reporting that some parents are following them through the barriers into their car park which is private property. Please ensure that the residents of Tomlinson Court can access their car park and do not block this driveway. If a local resident approaches you and asks you to move your vehicle as you are blocking them please do so and please refrain from using inappropriate language to them.

Local residents have been advised by the police to report any registration numbers causing problems directly to them. The police have also increased patrols in the area and tickets and fines have already been issued to a number of parents.
