Dear Parents and Carers

Reporting absences due to Covid

On Tuesday 11 January the rules of testing are changing so if you do regularly check your children on a lateral flow test, you will know that it may be positive even though your child has shown no symptoms. If this is the case, please ensure your child self-isolates in line with the current government guidelines.

If your child does test positive on a lateral flow test, we require the following from you:

- a picture of the lateral flow test
- a copy of the email you receive after reporting the result to https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result

A reminder to all that the new lateral flow tests in the white and green box need to be read after 15 minutes and the result is invalid after 30 minutes (i.e. it might show positive but not be!) This means that if the lateral flow result shows as negative within 15-30 minutes, your result is negative. If a faint line appears after this time it should be treated as invalid and you can retest if needed.

Family benefits and free school meals

If you think your child is entitled to free school meals can you please contact the office who will assist you in sorting this out. Also, please note that if your child receives the school dinner free because they are in younger age groups that this will stop once they go into Year 3. However, children who are on free school meals and are part of the pupil premium list will receive additional benefits such as free school uniform, assistance with school trips and are given a device to use at home.

If you think you qualify for this because your family are in receipt of universal credit please contact the office so we can make sure all children receive their entitlement.
