Move It Boom March

Move It Boom March! This has begun this week! We were delighted to welcome Mr Khan and Miss Phillips from the Leicestershire Sports Partnership team on Monday morning to our assembly. They brought Active Anita with them to tell the children all about how important it is to be active! All children have a recording sheet and there are prizes to be won! Let's get active!





Move it March began on Wednesday 1 March. We had an exciting assembly on Monday morning, led by the Learning South Leicestershire School Sports Partnership (LSLSSP) and even had Active Anita visit the children too!

Your child will have brought home an Activity Tracker where they can colour an icon to show each 15 minutes of activity completed. Activities may be walking, running, virtual workouts, PE lessons or any exercise that requires physical exertion.

There are 67 icons to complete in total and the following milestones and points will be rewarded, contributing to their class and schools Move It March score:

250 minutes - Bronze Award = 1 point

500 minutes- Silver Award = 2 points

750 minutes- Gold Award = 3 points

1000 minutes- Platinum Award= 5 points

Children can fill in more than one tracker to win more points for their class/school.

If Platinum is achieved, participants become a 'Oadby and Wigston Wolves Active Champion' and will be entered into a prize draw to win prizes that we are giving away. The most active class in each school will win a trophy. The most active school will also win a prize.
